## **BOURGOGNE PINOT NOIR**

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### **INTRODUCTION**

Pinot Noir is an important varietal in the history of French grape varieties. Known as the Noirien in the Middle Ages, it is the ancestor of a number of varieties found in Burgundy today (Gamay, Chardonnay, Aligoté and several others). The history of this varietal with naturally low yields is inextricably linked to the production of great fine wines.

### **TERROIRS**

Limestone, pebble and clay hillsides  
East/South-West exposure

### **VINIFICATION & AGEING**

Harvested by hand and transported in crates, vinification in open vats, cap punching and pumping over operations, indigenous yeasts, 100% destemmed, aged in vats and oak barrels for 10-12 months. Bottled without filtration.

### **TASTING**

Crisp, clean red berry aromas and flavours  
Service temperature: 16/17°  
Cellaring : 4/5 years
